

Good Morning Waterford Lakes,

Today certain areas of the Waterford Recreation Center are soft opening to our residents. As we are all anxious to get back to normal, the WLCA Board and staff have worked hard to ensure the safety and well-being of its residents and we don't want to put our community in harms way as we work through the COVID-19 pandemic. Patience continues to be the key.

The pool will open to a limited number of users. The availability of chairs and use is based on CDC guidance and safe social distancing. We have placed lounge chairs 6 feet apart and will be limiting entry based on the number of chairs that are available at the time. If there is no seat available, the pool guard will not allow you to enter to use the pool. Bathrooms are open and will be maintained daily.

Tennis courts, dog park and all fields are open for use with the caveat that you will be required to practice social distancing. Areas that remain closed are the exercise areas and the basketball court (and by default the racquetball courts due to their location and entry point being the basketball courts) and the playgrounds. I anticipate these areas will open up on future dates as each phase of opening comes to pass.

If you need a Recreation Center ID, please call the office to make an appointment for the photo ID. Remember, everyone entering the Rec Center will need an ID that matched the picture on that ID.
